Notice of the Launch of “WIN Asset,” a Cloud-Based Medical Device and Asset Management Service

As announced on December 8, 2025, WIN INTERNATIONAL has acquired the “HITOTSU Asset” medical device management system business previously operated by HITOTSU INC.

The Company has renamed the business “WIN Asset” and launched the service on April 1, 2026, featuring a new logo.

management, as well as the automatic retrieval of package inserts and recall information based on PMDA public data.

Furthermore, by providing a user interface that can be intuitively used by multiple departments within a hospital including clinical engineers, nursing departments, administrative departments, and clerical departments, the system contributes to smoother information sharing and improved audit readiness.
